- 1 WHEREAS, Memories of a life well lived remain to comfort the
- 2 family and friends of Huy Quang Luong of Houston, who passed away on
- 3 January 11, 2021, at the age of 75; and
- WHEREAS, The son of Van Hue Luong and My Thi Pham, Huy Quang
- 5 Luong was born in Hanoi, Vietnam, on July 29, 1945; although he
- 6 studied to be an attorney, the Vietnam War broke out before he had
- 7 the opportunity to practice law, and he went on to serve as a second
- 8 lieutenant for the South Vietnamese military during the war; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Luong married Lan Mac Huong, with whom he raised
- 10 two children, Amber and Jason; on April 29, 1975, the day before the
- 11 fall of Saigon, he fled the country with his family and was rescued
- 12 by the United States Navy's Seventh Fleet; as a refugee in the U.S.,
- 13 he first took a job in the cafeteria at Lackland Air Force Base in
- 14 San Antonio, and by attending night school at Our Lady of the Lake
- 15 University, he was able to earn a degree in accounting; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Relocating to Houston, Mr. Luong was hired as an
- 17 accountant with the city government, and he was later honored by
- 18 Mayor Bob Lanier for his more than 20 years of service; he also
- 19 operated a successful company, Hometeq Real Estate, and became a
- 20 pioneer in real estate in Houston's Vietnamese American community;
- 21 along the way, he benefited his fellow citizens through his
- 22 involvement in various volunteer and charitable organizations,
- 23 including the Lions Club; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Mr. Luong supported his children throughout their

- 1 studies at college, law school, medical school, and graduate
- 2 school, and he was proud to see both of them build successful
- 3 careers for themselves; his family also grew to include six
- 4 grandchildren, Lucas, Hayden, Caily, Sofia, Daniel, and Marissa,
- 5 whom he adored; in later life, he and his wife enjoyed traveling the
- 6 world together; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Huy Quang Luong touched countless lives during his
- 8 journey on this earth, and he will forever hold a special place in
- 9 the hearts of those who held him dear; now, therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 11 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Huy Quang Luong and
- 12 extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife of
