1 WHEREAS, In commemoration of Gold Star Mother's Day on 2 September 26, 2021, members of American Gold Star Mothers are 3 gathering across the nation in heartfelt tribute to the sons and 4 daughters who have given their lives in service to their country; 5 and

WHEREAS, Incorporated in 1929, American Gold Star Mothers is 6 composed of women whose children, as U.S. service personnel, were 7 killed in action during times of war or conflict; its name comes 8 from the custom of hanging a service flag for each member of the 9 military, with blue stars for living soldiers and gold stars 10 11 representing those who perished in battle; in their efforts to help 12 perpetuate the memory of their loved ones, Gold Star Mothers host remembrance events, perform volunteer work at veterans hospitals, 13 14 and promote a message of respect and reverence for members of the armed forces; and 15

16 WHEREAS, Gold Star Mother's Day is observed on the last 17 Sunday in September, and each year, the president of the United 18 States issues a proclamation for the event that calls on all 19 citizens to display the Stars and Stripes as an expression of 20 appreciation and support for Gold Star Mothers and their families; 21 and

WHEREAS, Americans owe profound and eternal gratitude to those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in defense of our freedom, and Gold Star Mother's Day provides a fitting time to
