3 High School Women's Powerlifting Association state meet, held on
4 March 17 and 18 in Corpus Christi; and

6 12 points, which placed them sixth out of the 56 schools
7 participating in the 1A/2A event; and

9 performances of all three of its participants; in the 97-pound
10 weight class, Faith Quiroz claimed second place by lifting a total
11 of 575 pounds; equally impressive was Reagan Barrera, who captured

13 in addition, Kayleigh Hernandez totaled 805 pounds in the 220-pound
14 division, which earned her fourth place; and
