3 2021, at the age of 71; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Robstown to Mateo and Margarita Espinoza  
5 Caballero on February 8, 1949, Enrique Espinoza Caballero grew up  
6 with the companionship of 10 siblings, Alfonso, Ruben, Lala,

17 pride in his three children, Henry, Jeanette, and Matthew, and he  
18 delighted in the time he spent with his seven grandchildren; and

19           WHEREAS, Enrique Espinoza Caballero was a brave soldier, a  
20 caring husband and father, and an engaged member of his community,  
21 and the contributions he made in each of these roles will long  
22 inspire those who were fortunate enough to know him; now,
