

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The wrestlers from Tascosa High School in Amarillo  
2 earned great distinction with their performances at the 2021  
3 University Interscholastic League Wrestling State Tournament; and

4           WHEREAS, After achieving success throughout the regular  
5 season, the Rebels excelled at the Region 1-5A tournament; the  
6 Tascosa girls' team finished third overall, with Elsaiah Cruz  
7 winning an individual gold medal and Zurri Zamora and Miliyah  
8 Pacheco each contributing second-place finishes; for the Tascosa  
9 boys, Andres Suarez qualified for state with a silver-medal  
10 showing; and

11           WHEREAS, On April 23 and 24, the Tascosa wrestlers joined the  
12 other top performers in Texas at the state meet in Cypress; the  
13 Rebels claimed the bronze medal in the 5A girls' team competition  
14 with a total of 59 points; Ms. Zamora and Ms. Pacheco both earned  
15 silver medals for their respective efforts in the 95-pound and  
16 102-pound divisions, and Ms. Cruz finished fifth at 128 pounds; in  
17 the 5A boys' events, Mr. Suarez clinched a bronze medal in his  
18 145-pound class; and

19           WHEREAS, The Rebels received valuable contributions over the  
20 course of the season from each member of the team rosters; these  
21 determined student-athletes were ably guided by head coach Joe  
22 Stafford, boys' assistant coach Nicholas Herrmann, and girls'  
23 assistant coach Donna Welch; and

24           WHEREAS, Through hard work and an unwavering resolve to give

1 their very best, the Tascosa Rebels have earned the admiration of  
2 their fellow students and their many community supporters, and they  
3 may indeed reflect with pride on their memorable accomplishments;  
4 now, therefore, be it

5         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas  
6 Legislature hereby congratulate the competitors from Tascosa High  
7 School on their outstanding performances at the 2021 UIL Wrestling  
8 State Tournament and extend to all those associated with the boys'  
9 and girls' wrestling teams sincere best wishes for continued
