R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The boys' basketball team from Richardson High
2 School enjoyed an outstanding 2020-2021 season, advancing to the
3 semifinals of the 6A playoffs; and

4 WHEREAS, After losing only a single game in the regular
5 season, the Eagles captured the District 7-6A title and carried
6 their momentum into the playoffs; the team's exciting postseason
7 run began with double-digit victories against Arlington Bowie,
8 Lewisville Marcus, South Grand Prairie, and Northwest Nelson High
9 Schools; and

10 WHEREAS, Richardson took the floor against Dallas Jesuit High
11 in the regional finals on March 5; combining strong perimeter
12 defense with sharp passing, the Eagles took a commanding 49-29 lead
13 after tearing off an 18-6 run to open the third quarter; the
14 Richardson players held Jesuit to 20 points in the second half and
15 triumphed by a final score of 66-43 to reach the state tournament
16 for the first time since 1987; in the semifinals, the Eagles gave
17 their all in a tough battle against Duncanville High School but fell
18 short, concluding the year with an impressive overall record of 26
19 wins and just two losses; and

20 WHEREAS, Throughout the season, the Eagles received valuable
21 contributions from each member of the roster: Jaylon Barnett, Tahje
22 Thomas, Pharaoh Amadi, Rylan Griffen, Dequinton Williams, Trevion
23 Howell, Charlie Gillette, Lorenzo Pearson, Rustan Griffen, Cason
24 Wallace, Derek Burns, and Gannon Parker; these determined

1 student-athletes were ably guided by head coach Kevin Lawson and
2 assistant coaches Mike Bangs, Lee Asemota, and Marlon McCoy, and
3 the team also benefited from the contributions of statistician
4 Damone Dixon; and

5 WHEREAS, Demonstrating a combination of exceptional talent
6 and fierce determination, the Richardson Eagles turned in an
7 unforgettable performance during the 2020-2021 campaign, and their
8 success is a source of great pride to their many supporters in the
9 local community; now, therefore, be it

11 Legislature hereby congratulate the Richardson High School boys'
12 basketball team on advancing to the 6A semifinals of the 2021 UIL
