- 1 WHEREAS, The West Texas A&M University men's basketball
- 2 program achieved a new level of success during the 2020-2021
- 3 season, as the Buffs advanced all the way to the NCAA Division II
- 4 national championship game; and
- 5 WHEREAS, WT compiled a 12-2 record in the regular season and
- 6 then cruised to three straight double-digit victories in the Lone
- 7 Star Conference tournament to capture the league title and clinch a
- 8 berth in the Division II NCAA tournament; and
- 9 WHEREAS, After defeating Dallas Baptist University and
- 10 Lubbock Christian University, WT bested Daemen College to earn a
- 11 trip to the Final Four in Evansville, Indiana; squaring off against
- 12 Lincoln Memorial University on March 25, WT was down by nine points
- 13 at the break but rallied in the second half to turn the game into a
- 14 nip-and-tuck battle; trailing by two points with 13 seconds
- 15 remaining, the Buffs missed a shot that would have tied the game,
- 16 but guard Zach Toussaint corralled the rebound beyond the arc and
- 17 threw up a last-second three-point attempt; the buzzer sounded with
- 18 the ball in the air, and when it fell through the net, WT claimed a
- 19 thrilling 87-86 triumph; moving on to the title game against
- 20 Northwest Missouri State University, the Buffs gave their all but
- 21 saw their season come to an end just one win short of the national
- 22 championship; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Excelling with a true team effort, the Buffs
- 24 received valuable contributions throughout the year from each
