R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Beverly Watts Davis, the chief operating officer of
2 the WestCare Foundation, has greatly benefited the San Antonio
3 community through the time and energy she has dedicated to many

6 WestCare Foundation has worked to address urgent community issues

20 appointments to the Police and Community Relations Council and the
21 Eastpoint Sustainability Committee; she also chairs the board of
22 directors of Ella Austin Community Center, and she serves on the
23 City Bond Committee and the United Way Women's Leadership Council;
