- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
- 2 Texas, 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, That House Rule 13,
- 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
- 4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
- 5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 713 (the sunset review
- 6 process and certain governmental entities subject to that process)
- 7 to consider and take action on the following matters:
- 8 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
- 9 the committee to add text on matters not included in either the
- 10 house or senate version of the bill by adding the following new
- 11 SECTIONS to the bill:
- 12 SECTION 1.03. ANATOMICAL BOARD OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.
- 13 Section 691.003, Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 Sec. 691.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The Anatomical Board of
- 16 the State of Texas is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas
- 17 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that
- 18 chapter, the board is abolished September 1, 2023 [2021].
- 19 SECTION 1.04. TEXAS COMMISSION OF LICENSING AND REGULATION;
- 20 TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATION. Section 51.002(a),
- 21 Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation and the
- 23 Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation are subject to Chapter
- 24 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in

- 1 existence as provided by that chapter, the commission and the
- 2 department are abolished September 1, 2023 [2021].
- 3 SECTION 1.05. TEXAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT. (a)
- 4 Section 1701.002, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1701.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas
- 6 Commission on Law Enforcement is subject to Chapter 325, Government
- 7 Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided
- 8 by that chapter, the commission is abolished and this chapter
- 9 expires September 1, 2023 [2021].
- 10 (b) For purposes of Section 1701.002, Occupations Code, as
- 11 amended by this Act, the Sunset Advisory Commission shall conduct a
- 12 limited-scope review of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement for
- 13 the 88th Legislature.
- 14 (c) In conducting the limited-scope review under this
- 15 section, the Sunset Advisory Commission staff evaluation and report
- 16 must be limited to reviewing the appropriateness of the Sunset
- 17 Advisory Commission's recommendations for the Texas Commission on
- 18 Law Enforcement made to the 87th Legislature.
- 19 (d) The Sunset Advisory Commission's recommendations to the
- 20 88th Legislature may include any recommendation the commission
- 21 considers appropriate based on the limited-scope review conducted
- 22 under this section.
- 23 SECTION 3.04. TEXAS RACING COMMISSION. (a) Section
- 24 2021.008(a), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 25 (a) The commission is subject to Chapter 325, Government
- 26 Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided
- 27 by that chapter, and except as provided by Subsections (b) and (c),

- 1 the commission is abolished and this subtitle expires September 1,
- 2 2027 [2021].
- 3 (b) Not later than December 1, 2021, the Texas Racing
- 4 Commission shall replace all employees who were employed by the
- 5 Texas Racing Commission on August 31, 2021, in:
- 6 (1) an exempt position; or
- 7 (2) a position at or above salary group B27 in the
- 8 Texas Position Classification Plan, 1961.
- 9 (c) The Texas Racing Commission may not hire or rehire an
- 10 individual to fill a position described by Subsection (b) of this
- 11 section if the individual was employed by the commission in a
- 12 position described by Subsection (b) of this section during the six
- 13 months preceding the effective date of this Act.
- Explanation: This addition is necessary to limit the scope of
- 15 the next sunset review of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement,
- 16 to replace certain employees of the Texas Racing Commission, and to
- 17 change the sunset review date for various state agencies.
- 18 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
- 19 the committee to add text on a matter not included in either the
- 20 house or senate version of the bill by adding the following new
- 21 SECTION to the bill:
- 22 ARTICLE 9. TRANSITION
- 23 SECTION 9.01. CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAWS. If a conflict
- 24 exists between this Act and another Act of the 87th Legislature,
- 25 Regular Session, 2021, that amends or repeals the sunset date of a
- 26 governmental entity, the provisions of the other Act control
- 27 without regard to the relative dates of enactment.

- 1 Explanation: This addition is necessary to address any
- 2 conflicts with other legislation enacted by the 87th Legislature,
- 3 Regular Session, 2021.
