1 WHEREAS, Residents of the Roma community lost a beloved
2 friend and neighbor with the passing of Onofre Baldemar Rodriguez
3 on January 20, 2021, at the age of 72; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Roma, Onofre Rodriguez was born on April
5 22, 1948, to Jose and Aurora Garza Rodriguez; he was raised in a
6 large family with 11 siblings, Alicia, Elva, Juan, Fernando,
7 Lupita, Maria, Jose, Claudia, Roel, Norma, and Hector, and he grew
8 to love the outdoors from an early age; known for his skill with
9 horses, he earned a reputation as a true Starr County *vaquero*; and

10 WHEREAS, In his younger years, Mr. Rodriguez served the
11 community in various law enforcement capacities, including as
12 Roma's police chief from 1973 to 1975; he was later employed with
13 the USDA as a tick inspector from 1978 to 1998, which provided him
14 the opportunity to work for the benefit of the ranching community;
15 he was always willing to lend an ear or a helping hand to anyone in
16 need, and he was held in high regard around town for his honesty,
17 integrity, and wisdom; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Rodriguez was blessed with the love and support
19 of his wife of 47 years, Susanna Salazar Rodriguez; the couple
20 raised four daughters, Veronica, Annette, Monica, and Georginna,
21 and he also knew the joy of becoming a grandfather to numerous
22 grandchildren; he endeared himself to many friends, and he
23 especially treasured the companionship of his lifelong best friend,
24 Heriberto Garcia; and

1 WHEREAS, Although Onofre Rodriguez will be deeply missed by
2 all who were privileged to know him, they will forever treasure
3 their memories of his kind, generous nature and his great devotion
4 to his family and community; now, therefore, be it

6 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Onofre Baldemar
