16 the VFW and gave generously to veterans support organizations; in
17 addition, he served on the Brooks County Fair Association Board and
18 as president of the FFA Booster Club during the late 1980s and early
19 1990s; and

20 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Garcia enjoyed the love
21 and support of his wife, Angelica, and he took great pride in his
22 children, Juan, Annessa, and Jessica; with the passing years, he
23 had the pleasure of seeing his family grow to include seven
24 grandchildren, Krizia, Kayla, Kody, Juan, Jose, Jacob, and Jenise,

1 and three great-grandchildren, J'La, Kezelle, and Kyra; and

2 WHEREAS, Those who were privileged to share in this esteemed
3 man's love and friendship will always remember him with great
4 admiration and affection; now, therefore, be it
