R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will forever treasure their
2 memories of John Stanley Vyvlecka Jr., who died on October 6, 2020,
3 at the age of 83; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of John and Marcella Vyvlecka, John Vyvlecka
5 was born in Poteet on January 13, 1937, and grew up with a brother,
6 James; he shared a loving union with his wife, the former Mary Ann
7 Marek, that spanned nearly six decades, and he was the proud father
8 of three children, Brady, Deanna, and Scot; with the passing years,
9 he had the pleasure of seeing his family grow to include four
10 grandchildren, Collin, Faith, Derek, and Dylan, and a
11 great-granddaughter, Fallon; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Vyvlecka graduated from Jourdanton High School
13 in 1957 and enlisted in the U.S. Navy, serving until 1961; he began
14 his civilian career at Lewis Plumbing and Electricity in Uvalde,
15 and he went on to become a maintenance technician at Mercy Hospital
16 in Jourdanton; working out of Jourdanton Hardware, he and his
17 brother also repaired air conditioners at night; and

18 WHEREAS, A man of deep faith, Mr. Vyvlecka attended
19 St. Matthew and St. Andrew Catholic Churches in Atascosa County,
20 and he served his community as a volunteer firefighter and a member
21 of the VFW; a true outdoorsman, he delighted in camping, hunting,
22 fishing, and collecting arrowheads; he also enjoyed traveling with
23 his wife to Las Vegas, Hawaii, Bermuda, Ireland, Portugal, Jamaica,
24 and the Bahamas; and

1 WHEREAS, John Vyvlecka lived a rich and purposeful life
2 centered around his family, his community, and his faith, and he
3 will long be remembered with deep affection by all who knew him;
4 now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
6 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of John Stanley
7 Vyvlecka Jr. and extend heartfelt sympathy to his relatives and
