R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories  
2 of Roger Olivares Cumpian, who passed away on July 5, 2020, at the  
3 age of 89; and

4           WHEREAS, Roger Cumpian was born on June 20, 1931, to Adolph  
5 and Anna Cumpian, and he grew up with eight siblings, Johnny,  
6 Adolph, Alice, Ernestine, Irene, Mary Helen, Stella, and Beatrice;  
7 answering his nation's call to duty, he served in the U.S. Army  
8 during the Korean War, and he went on to work as a farmer and rancher  
9 in Atascosa County; and

10           WHEREAS, A valued member of his community, Mr. Cumpian  
11 participated in a number of notable civic organizations, including  
12 the Charlotte ISD school board, the Atascosa Peanut Growers  
13 Association, the Atascosa County Cattlemen's Association, the  
14 Atascosa County Farm Bureau, the Atascosa County Farm Service  
15 Agency, and the Texas Farmers Union; in addition, he served as a  
16 director of the Atascosa County Historical Commission and the  
17 Atascosa Family Crisis Center, and he was a lifetime member of the  
18 VFW and the American Legion; a man of strong faith, he gave  
19 generously of his time and talents to churches in Charlotte and Big  
20 Foot, as well as to the Archdiocese of San Antonio Finance Council;

22           WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Cumpian enjoyed the love  
23 and support of his wife, Mary Jane, with whom he shared a rewarding  
24 marriage that spanned 63 years before her passing; he was the proud

1 father of four children, Roger, Gene, Gary, and JoAnn, and through  
2 the years, he was further blessed with six grandchildren, Roger,  
3 Anthony, Amanda, Jodie, Bobby, and Garrett, and four  
4 great-grandchildren, Alyssa, Kaiah, Athena, and Gema; and

5 WHEREAS, Deeply dedicated to his family, his faith, and his  
6 community, Roger Cumpian earned the lasting respect and admiration  
7 of all who were privileged to know him, and he leaves behind a  
8 record of service that his loved ones can remember with pride; now,
