2 of Herschel Harold Hall of Cotulla, who passed away on June 27,  
3 2020, at the age of 87; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Harrison Township, Missouri, on May 28,  
5 1933, Herschel Hall was the son of Ray and Thelma Hall, and he grew  
6 up with the companionship of two brothers, Leon and Ray; he moved to  
7 Texas with his family and attended school in Alice and Kerrville;  
8 following his graduation from William Adams High School in Alice,  
9 he answered his nation's call to duty and served in the United  
10 States Army, and he was stationed at Eielson Air Force Base in  
11 Alaska; and

12           WHEREAS, Returning to civilian life, Mr. Hall began working  
13 as a heavy equipment operator in a Texas oilfield; he later spent  
14 many years working for Tommy Martin and became a dear friend to the  
15 Martin family; and

16           WHEREAS, Mr. Hall was joined in matrimony to the former Rose  
17 Marie Malott in 1978, and the couple made their home in Texas and  
18 Florida; a valued congregant of the First United Methodist Church  
19 in Cotulla, he dedicated his later years to serving his  
20 congregation; he was a talented artist and enjoyed drawing and  
21 painting throughout his life, and he always looked forward to  
22 playing dominoes with his friends; and

23           WHEREAS, A man who delighted in the simple pleasures,  
24 Herschel Hall treasured the richness that each day brought, and he

1 will long be remembered with deep affection by all who knew him;  
2 now, therefore, be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas  
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Herschel Harold Hall  
5 and extend sincere condolences to all who mourn his passing; and, be
