

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Retired district court judge Steven C. Hilbig served
2 Bexar County residents with distinction in a number of roles over
3 the course of a long legal career; and

4 WHEREAS, Elected as a judge of the 187th District Court in
5 2014, Judge Hilbig remained in that post until his retirement in
6 2017; he previously served a term as a judge of the Fourth District
7 Court of Appeals, and he was employed in the office of the Bexar
8 County Criminal District Attorney for eight years; while there, he
9 was promoted to the felony section, where he prosecuted defendants
10 charged with the most serious violent crimes and assisted in two
11 capital murder cases; and

12 WHEREAS, Along the way, Judge Hilbig also worked in private
13 practice, both as a solo attorney and with the Sessions & Sessions
14 and Holland & Knight firms; he began his career as an assistant
15 district attorney in Bexar County in 1977 and served from 1981 to
16 1984 as an assistant U.S. attorney in the Western District of Texas;
17 a graduate of The University of Texas at Austin, he earned his
18 bachelor's degree in American studies before going on to complete
19 his law degree; and

20 WHEREAS, Steven Hilbig greatly benefited his fellow citizens
21 through his service in the judicial system, and he may indeed
22 reflect with pride on his accomplishments; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
24 Legislature hereby honor Steven C. Hilbig for his contributions to
