

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 87th Legislature, Regular Session 2021, That House Rule 13,
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 1281 (a reliability
6 assessment of the ERCOT power grid and certificates of public
7 convenience and necessity for certain transmission projects) to
8 consider and take action on the following matter:

9 House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (3) are suspended to
10 permit the committee to change, alter, or amend text which is not in
11 disagreement and add text on a matter which is not in disagreement
12 in proposed SECTION 1 of the bill by adding Sections
13 37.052(c)(1)(A) and (B), Utilities Code, to read as follows:

- 14 (1) the transmission line does not exceed:
15 (A) three miles in length, if the line connects
16 to a load-serving substation or metering point; or
17 (B) two miles in length, if the line connects to a
18 generation substation or metering point;

1 Explanation: The change is necessary to distinguish that an
2 electric transmission line to which Subsection 37.056(c),
3 Utilities Code, as added by this bill, applies must measure three
4 miles or less for a load-serving electric transmission line and two
5 miles or less for an electric transmission line that connects to
6 power generation.
