## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 Texas, 87th Legislature, Regular Session 2021, That House Rule 13, 2 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 1281 (a reliability assessment of the ERCOT power grid and certificates of public 6 7 convenience and necessity for certain transmission projects) to consider and take action on the following matter: 8

9 House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (3) are suspended to permit the committee to change, alter, or amend text which is not in 10 disagreement and add text on a matter which is not in disagreement 11 12 proposed SECTION 1 of the bill by adding in Sections 37.052(c)(1)(A) and (B), Utilities Code, to read as follows: 13

14 (1) the transmission line does not exceed: 15 (A) three miles in length, if the line connects 16 to a load-serving substation or metering point; or

17 (B) two miles in length, if the line connects to a

18 generation substation or metering point;

19 Explanation: The change is necessary to distinguish that an transmission line to which 20 electric Subsection 37.056(c), 21 Utilities Code, as added by this bill, applies must measure three miles or less for a load-serving electric transmission line and two 22 miles or less for an electric transmission line that connects to 23 24 power generation.

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
