- The omitted text 11 prohibited the offering of certain wholesale indexed electric 12 products to residential or small commercial customers. The omitted 13 14 text reads:
- Sec. 39.110. WHOLESALE INDEXED PRODUCTS PROHIBITED. 15 In this section, "wholesale indexed product" means a retail 16 electric product in which the price a customer pays for electricity 17 includes a direct pass-through of real-time settlement point prices 18 19 determined by the independent organization certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power region. 20
- 21 (b) A retail electric provider may not offer a wholesale indexed product to a residential or small commercial customer. 22
- Sec. 39.110. WHOLESALE INDEXED PRODUCTS. (a) 23 In this 24 section, "wholesale indexed product" means a retail electric
