Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, S.B. No. 2 (Hancock/Paddie)

RESOLUTION

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 2 Texas, 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, That House Rule 13, 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 2 (the governance of the 5 Public Utility Commission of Texas, the Office of Public Utility 6 7 Counsel, and an independent organization certified to manage a power region) to consider and take action on the following matters: 8

9 (1)House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1), (3), and (4), are 10 suspended to permit the committee to amend text not in disagreement, to add text on a matter not in disagreement, and to 11 add text on a matter not included in either the house or senate 12 version of the bill in proposed SECTION 3 of the bill, in amended 13 14 Sections 39.151(g) and (g-1), Utilities Code, and added Sections 39.151(g-2), (g-3), and (g-4), Utilities Code, to read as follows: 15

16 maintain certification (g) To as an independent organization for the ERCOT power region under this section, an 17 organization's governing body must be composed of persons selected 18 19 by the ERCOT board selection committee [specified by this section and selected in accordance with formal bylaws or protocols of 20 +ho 21 organization].

22 <u>(g-1)</u> The <u>independent organization's</u> bylaws or protocols 23 must be approved by the commission and must reflect the input of the 24 commission. [The bylaws must specify the process by which

appropriate stakeholders elect members and, for unaffiliated 1 members, prescribe professional qualifications for selection as a 2 3 member.] The bylaws must require that every member of the governing body be a resident of this state and must prohibit a legislator from 4 serving as a member [the use of a professional search firm to 5 identify candidates for membership of unaffiliated members. The 6 process must allow for commission input in identifying candidates]. 7 8 The governing body must be composed of: 9 (1) the chairman of the commission as an ex officio 10 nonvoting member; (2) the counsellor as an ex officio voting member 11 representing residential and small commercial consumer interests; 12 (3) the chief executive officer of the independent 13 14 organization as an ex officio nonvoting [voting] member; and 15 (4) eight members selected by the selection committee 16 under Section 39.1513 with executive-level experience in any of the 17 following professions: (A) <u>finance;</u> 18 19 (B) business; 20 (C) engineering, including electrical engineering; 21 22 (D) trading; 23 (E) risk management; 24 (F) law; or (G) electric market design 25 [six market 26 participants elected by their respective market segments to serve one-year terms, with: 27

1	[(A) one representing independent generators;
2	[(B) one representing investor-owned utilities;
3	[(C) one representing power marketers;
4	[(D) one representing retail electric providers;
5	[(E) one representing municipally owned
6	utilities; and
7	[(F) one representing electric cooperatives;
8	[(5) one member representing industrial consumer
9	interests and elected by the industrial consumer market segment to
10	serve a one-year term;
11	[(6) one member representing large commercial
12	consumer interests selected in accordance with the bylaws to serve
13	a one-year term; and
14	[(7) five members unaffiliated with any market segment
15	and selected by the other members of the governing body to serve
16	<pre>three=year terms].</pre>
17	<u>(g-2) Members</u> [(g-1) The presiding officer] of the
18	governing body are entitled to receive a salary for their service
19	[must be one of the members described by Subsection (g)(7)].
20	(g-3) A person does not qualify for selection as a member of
21	the governing body of an independent organization for the ERCOT
22	power region if the person has a fiduciary duty or assets in the
23	electricity market for that region.
24	(g-4) To maintain certification as an independent
25	organization under this section, the organization's governing body
26	may not include more than two members who are employed by an
27	institution of higher education, as defined by Section 61.003,

1 Education Code, in a professorial role.

Explanation: This change is necessary to provide for the composition of the governing body of an independent organization certified under Section 39.151, Utilities Code, for the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region and to establish requirements relating to the eligibility and selection of members of the governing body.

8 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit 9 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in SECTION 3 of the 10 senate engrossment of Senate Bill 2 and the corresponding bill as 11 the bill was amended by the house in added Section 39.151(g-2), 12 Utilities Code. The omitted text reads:

13 (g-2) A person does not qualify for appointment as a member 14 of the governing body of an independent organization under 15 Subsection (g)(3) or (7) if the person is required to register as a 16 lobbyist under Chapter 305, Government Code. In making an 17 appointment under Subsection (g)(3) or (7), the governor:

18 (1) shall give preference to a person who has 19 <u>executive-level</u> business experience representing a range of 20 industries; and

21 (2) may consider a person recommended by the 22 legislature.
23 (g-2) A person does not qualify for selection as a member of

23 the governing body of an independent organization under Subsection 24 the governing body of an independent organization under Subsection 25 (g)(3) or (7) if the person is required to register as a lobbyist 26 under Chapter 305, Government Code. In making a selection under 27 Subsection (g)(3) or (7), the members of the governing body shall

1 give preference to a person who has executive-level business 2 experience representing a range of industries.

3 Explanation: The change is necessary to omit the 4 qualification and selection requirements.

5 (3) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit 6 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in SECTION 3 of the 7 senate engrossment of Senate Bill 2 and the corresponding bill as 8 the bill was amended by the house in added Section 39.151(g-3), 9 Utilities Code. The omitted text reads:

(g-3) Members of the governing body of an independent 10 organization certified under this section must serve staggered 11 12 terms. A member described by Subsection (g)(4) or (5) must serve a term that expires in an even-numbered year. A member described by 13 Subsection (g)(6) or (7) must serve a term that expires in an 14 15 odd-numbered year. As soon as practicable after the date a member of the governing body's term expires, the appropriate authority must 16 17 appoint or arrange for the election of a replacement in the same manner as the original appointment or election. If a vacancy occurs 18 19 on the governing body, the appropriate authority must appoint or arrange for the election of a successor in the same manner as the 20 original appointment or election to serve for the remainder of the 21 22 unexpired term.

23 Explanation: The change is necessary to omit the term and 24 vacancy requirements.

(4) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the committee to add text on a matter not included in either the house or senate version of the bill by adding the following new

1 SECTION to the bill: 2 SECTION 4. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is 3 amended by adding Section 39.1513 to read as follows: 4 Sec. 39.1513. ERCOT BOARD SELECTION COMMITTEE. (a) The ERCOT board selection committee is composed of: 6 (1) one member appointed by the governor; 7 (2) one member appointed by the lieutenant governor; 8 and (3) one member appointed by the speaker of the house of 9 10 representatives. (b) A person may not be appointed as a member of the 11 12 committee unless the person is a resident of this state. (c) A member of the committee is not entitled to 13 compensation for serving as a member but is entitled 14 to 15 reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in performing the official duties of office. 16 17 (d) The committee shall select members eligible under Section 39.151 to serve on the governing body of an independent 18 19 organization certified under that section for the ERCOT power region and shall designate the chair and vice chair of the governing 20 body from those members. 21 (e) The ERCOT board selection committee shall retain an 22 outside consulting firm to help select members of the governing 23 24 body under Subsection (d). 25 Explanation: The addition is necessary to provide for the 26 creation of a committee to select the members of a governing body of 27 independent organization certified under Section 39.151, an

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Utilities Code, for the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power
 region.

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3 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit (5) 4 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in SECTION 4 of the senate engrossment of Senate Bill 2 and the corresponding bill as 5 6 the bill was amended by the house that would require an independent organization certified by the Public Utility Commission of Texas 7 8 under Section 39.151, Utilities Code, to modify the organization to 9 comply with Section 39.151, Utilities Code, as amended by the bill, not later than September 1, 2021. The omitted language reads: "not 10 later than September 1, 2021". 11

Explanation: The omission is necessary to provide sufficient time for the ERCOT Board Selection Committee to be formed and for the committee to select members of the governing body of the independent organization certified under Section 39.151, Utilities Code, for the Electric Reliability Council of Texas power region.
