4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 10, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 2062 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 2062. PROHIBITIONS ON DISSEMINATION BY STATE AGENCY OF
8	CERTAIN PERSONAL DATA
9	Sec. 2062.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Individual" means a natural person.
11	(2) "Personal data" means any information relating to
12	an identified or identifiable individual that directly or
13	indirectly identifies the individual by reference to:
14	(A) an identifier for the individual, including a
15	name, an identification number, location information, or an online
16	<pre>identifier; or</pre>
17	(B) one or more factors specific to the physical,
18	physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural, or social
19	identity of the individual.
20	(3) "State agency" means a department, commission,
21	board, office, council, authority, or other agency in the
22	executive, legislative, or judicial branch of state government,
23	including a university system or institution of higher education as
24	defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, that is created by the

- 1 constitution or a statute of this state.
- 2 Sec. 2062.002. PROHIBITED DISSEMINATION. (a) A state
- 3 agency may not disseminate to any person any personal data of an
- 4 individual without the individual's written consent.
- 5 (b) A state agency shall retain the written consent of an
- 6 individual obtained as required under Subsection (a) in the
- 7 agency's records until the agreement under which the personal data
- 8 is disseminated expires or is otherwise terminated.
- 9 (c) A state agency may not require an individual to consent
- 10 to dissemination of the individual's personal data in exchange for
- 11 access to the services provided by the agency or to the agency's
- 12 Internet website.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 2062, Government Code, as added by this
- 14 Act, applies only to information disseminated by a state agency to
- 15 another person on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
