A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring public school students to compete in
- 3 interscholastic athletic competitions based on sex and a study
- 4 conducted by the University Interscholastic League on the effects
- 5 of allowing a student to participate in an athletic competition
- 6 designated for the sex opposite to the student's sex.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 33.0832 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 33.0832. INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC COMPETITION BASED
- 11 ON SEX. (a) In this section, "league" means the University
- 12 <u>Interscholastic League.</u>
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an
- 14 interscholastic athletic team sponsored or authorized by a school
- 15 district or open-enrollment charter school may not allow a student
- 16 to compete in an interscholastic athletic competition sponsored or
- 17 authorized by the district or school that is designated for the sex
- 18 opposite to the student's sex as correctly stated on:
- 19 (1) the student's official birth certificate; or
- 20 (2) if the student's official birth certificate is
- 21 unobtainable, another government record.
- 22 (c) An interscholastic athletic team described by
- 23 Subsection (b) may allow a female student to compete in an
- 24 interscholastic athletic competition that is designated for male

- 1 students if a corresponding interscholastic athletic competition
- 2 designated for female students is not offered or available.
- 3 (d) The league shall conduct a study to determine if
- 4 allowing a student to participate in an interscholastic athletic
- 5 competition that is sponsored or authorized by a school district or
- 6 open-enrollment charter school and is designated for the sex
- 7 opposite to the student's sex:
- 8 (1) causes disruptions among the student's
- 9 interscholastic athletic team; or
- 10 (2) restricts opportunities for students of the sex
- 11 for which the competition is designated.
- 12 (e) Not later than December 1, 2026, the league shall submit
- 13 to the legislature a report on the results of the study conducted
- 14 under Subsection (d) and any recommendations for legislative or
- 15 other action.
- (f) The league shall adopt rules to implement this section,
- 17 provided that the rules must be approved by the commissioner in
- 18 <u>accordance with Section 33.083(b).</u>
- 19 (g) This section expires September 1, 2027.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
