A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to a study and report by the Texas Higher Education
3	Coordinating Board regarding best practices for assisting students
4	with autism spectrum disorder.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 61.06694 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 61.06694. STUDY AND REPORT ON ASSISTING STUDENTS WITH
9	AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER. (a) The board shall conduct a study to
10	determine best practices for assisting students with autism
11	spectrum disorder who are enrolled at institutions of higher
12	education.
13	(b) The study must:
14	(1) identify and track:
15	(A) the number of students with autism spectrum
16	disorder who graduate from secondary schools in this state;
17	(B) the number of students with autism spectrum
18	disorder who are enrolled at institutions of higher education;
19	(C) the student financial assistance available
20	to students with autism spectrum disorder who enroll at
21	institutions of higher education; and
22	(D) the graduation rates of students with autism
23	spectrum disorder who enroll at institutions of higher education;
24	and
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- 1 (2) identify and examine best practices and program
- 2 modules from public and private institutions of higher education
- 3 outside this state that have achieved successful results in working
- 4 with students with autism spectrum disorder.
- 5 (c) In conducting the study, the board shall collaborate
- 6 with school districts that offer specialized programs for students
- 7 with autism spectrum disorder to determine how those programs could
- 8 be replicated at or extended to postsecondary institutions.
- 9 (d) Not later than December 1, 2023, the board shall submit
- 10 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
- 11 of representatives, and the commissioner of education a written
- 12 report that includes the study's findings and any recommendations
- 13 for legislative or other action.
- 14 (e) This section expires January 1, 2024.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
