BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 571.071, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 7 follows:

8 (c) The commission may provide a seminar for persons 9 required to register under Chapter 305 that addresses issues 10 involving lobbying, political contributions and expenditures, and 11 other issues as determined by the commission. The commission may 12 charge a fee for attending the seminar in an amount necessary to 13 cover the costs associated with the seminar, including the cost of 14 providing food or nonalcoholic beverages to attendees.

15 (d) The commission may provide a seminar that addresses the 16 laws administered and enforced by the commission and any other 17 relevant laws, as determined by the commission. The commission may 18 charge a fee for attending the seminar in an amount necessary to 19 cover the costs associated with the seminar, including the cost of 20 providing food or nonalcoholic beverages to attendees.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
