- 21 Section 5.754, Water Code; [and]
- (2) the condition and effectiveness of existing 22 23 emission control equipment and practices; and
- 24 (3) the cumulative effects on the public's health and

- 1 physical property of expected air contaminant emissions from the
- 2 facility and from other facilities located less than three miles
- 3 from the facility.
- 4 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 5 the issuance or renewal of a permit for which an application is
- 6 filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or
- 7 after the effective date of this Act. The issuance or renewal of a
- 8 permit for which an application is filed with the Texas Commission
- 9 on Environmental Quality before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect when the application is filed, and the
- 11 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
