- 12 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a child if during the
- 13 2020-2021 school year the written statement of the child's
- 14 <u>individualized education program documents the information</u>
- 15 described under Subsections (a) (1) (4).
- (c) Section 29.005(f) and Section 29.0051 do not apply to a
- 17 supplement prepared for inclusion with a written statement of an
- 18 individualized education program, as required by this section.
- 19 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to

- 21 (e) This section expires September 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. Not later than May 1, 2022, a school district

- 26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
