## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to supplemental information required for inclusion with a

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the COVID-19 Special
- 8 Education Recovery Act.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 29.0052 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 29.0052. INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT.
- 12 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), for each child who was
- 13 enrolled in a school district's special education program under
- 14 this subchapter during the 2019-2020 school year or the 2020-2021
- 15 school year, the district shall prepare a supplement to be included
- 16 with the written statement of the individualized education program
- 17 developed for the child under Section 29.005(b). The supplement
- 18 must include information indicating:
- 19 (1) if applicable, whether the written report of the
- 20 child's full individual and initial evaluation under Section 29.004
- 21 was completed during the 2019-2020 school year or the 2020-2021
- 22 school year and, if so, whether the report was completed by the date
- 23 required under that section;
- 24 (2) if applicable, whether the child's initial

- 1 individualized education program was developed under Section
- 2 <u>29.005(b)</u> during the 2019-2020 school year or the 2020-2021 school
- 3 year and, if so, whether the program was developed by the date
- 4 required under 34 C.F.R. Section 300.323(c)(1);
- 5 (3) whether the provision of special services to the
- 6 child under an individualized education program during the
- 7 2019-2020 school year or the 2020-2021 school year was interrupted,
- 8 reduced, delayed, suspended, or discontinued; and
- 9 <u>(4) whether compensatory educational services are</u>
- 10 appropriate for the child based on the information under
- 11 Subdivisions (1)-(3) or any other factors.
- 12 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a child if during the
- 13 2020-2021 school year the written statement of the child's
- 14 <u>individualized education program documents the information</u>
- 15 described under Subsections (a) (1) (4).
- (c) Section 29.005(f) and Section 29.0051 do not apply to a
- 17 supplement prepared for inclusion with a written statement of an
- 18 individualized education program, as required by this section.
- 19 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to
- 20 implement this section.
- 21 (e) This section expires September 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. Not later than May 1, 2022, a school district
- 23 subject to Section 29.0052, Education Code, as added by this Act,
- 24 shall complete each required supplement to a written statement of
- 25 an individualized education program, as provided by that section.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
