12	waive the tuition and required fees that would otherwise be imposed
13	for the student for a number of semester credit hours equal to the
14	number of semester credit hours earned by the student in the core
15	curriculum or a field of study curriculum of the sending
16	institution for which the receiving institution:
17	(1) does not award the student academic credit toward

- SECTION 2. Section 61.827(a), Education Code, is amended to 20

- (a) The board is authorized to adopt rules implementing the 22

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 2 academic year.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
