- 13 (3) state the name of the owner or possessor of the 14 vehicle, container, or item identified under Subdivision (2);
- 15 (4) state the judicial jurisdictional area in which
- 16 the vehicle, container, or item identified under Subdivision (2) is
- 17 expected to be found; and
- 18 (5) state the facts and circumstances that provide the
- 19 applicant with probable cause to believe [a reasonable suspicion]
- 20 that:
- 21 (A) criminal activity has been, is, or will be
- 22 committed; and
- 23 (B) the installation and use of a mobile tracking
- 24 device is likely to produce information that is material to an

- 1 ongoing criminal investigation of that criminal activity.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
