## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) Each student shall be fully immunized against
- 8 bacterial meningitis, except as provided by Subsection (c). To
- 9 satisfy the requirement of this subsection, a student must show
- 10 proof of a quadrivalent meningococcal conjugate vaccine and a
- 11 booster dose of that vaccine in accordance with the recommended
- 12 immunization schedule adopted by the Department of State Health
- 13 Services, as well as any additional vaccine recommended for the
- 14 prevention of bacterial meningitis by the federal Centers for
- 15 Disease Control and Prevention. The executive commissioner of the
- 16 Health and Human Services Commission shall adopt rules for the
- 17 implementation of this subsection.
- 18 SECTION 2. Not later than June 1, 2022, the executive
- 19 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 20 adopt the rules necessary to implement Section 38.001(a-1),
- 21 Education Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. Section 38.001(a-1), Education Code, as added by
- 23 this Act, applies beginning with the 2022-2023 school year.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
