- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 208.001, Labor Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 9 (c) As soon as practicable after an individual files an
- 10 <u>initial claim for benefits</u>, the commission shall provide to the
- 11 individual a written notice containing general information about
- 12 <u>eligibility</u> and enrollment for health care insurance coverage under
- 13 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Pub. L.
- 14 No. 111-148) as amended by the Health Care and Education
- 15 Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Pub. L. No. 111-152). The commission
- 16 shall adopt rules for the form and content of the notice provided
- 17 under this subsection.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to an initial claim for unemployment compensation benefits filed
- 20 with the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date
- 21 of this Act. An initial claim filed before the effective date of
- 22 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the claim was
- 23 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
