A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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| 2 | relating to student loan repayment assistance for certain nurses |
| 3 | employed by a long-term care facility. |
| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Chapter 61, Education Code, is amended by adding |
| 6 | Subchapter N to read as follows: |
| 7 | SUBCHAPTER N. REPAYMENT OF EDUCATION LOANS FOR CERTAIN NURSES |
| 8 | Sec. 61.731. LOAN REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED. The |
| 9 | board shall provide, in accordance with this subchapter and board |
| 10 | rules, assistance in the repayment of eligible student loans for |
| 11 | eligible nurses who apply and qualify for the assistance. |
| 12 | Sec. 61.732. ELIGIBILITY. To be eligible to receive loan |
| 13 | repayment assistance under this subchapter, a nurse must: |
| 14 | (1) apply to the board in a manner prescribed by the |
| 15 | board; |
| 16 | (2) be an advanced practice registered nurse, |
| 17 | registered nurse, or licensed vocational nurse; and |
| 18 | (3) at the time of application for repayment |
| 19 | assistance have been employed full-time for at least one year by, |
| 20 | and currently be employed full-time by: |
| 21 | (A) a convalescent or nursing facility, as |
| 22 | defined by Chapter 242, Health and Safety Code; or |
| 23 | (B) a continuing care facility, as defined by |
| 24 | Chapter 246, Health and Safety Code. |

- 1 Sec. 61.733. LIMITATIONS. A nurse may receive loan
- 2 repayment assistance under this subchapter for not more than five
- 3 years.
- 4 Sec. 61.734. ELIGIBLE LOANS. (a) The board may provide
- 5 loan repayment assistance under this subchapter for the repayment
- 6 of any student loan for education at an institution of higher
- 7 education, a private or independent institution of higher
- 8 education, or a public or private out-of-state institution of
- 9 higher education accredited by a recognized accrediting agency,
- 10 including loans for undergraduate education, received by an
- 11 eligible person through any lender.
- 12 (b) The board may not provide repayment assistance for a
- 13 student loan that is in default at the time of the person's
- 14 application.
- 15 (c) In each state fiscal biennium, the board shall attempt
- 16 to allocate all funds appropriated to the board for the purpose of
- 17 providing loan repayment assistance under this subchapter.
- Sec. 61.735. REPAYMENT. (a) The board shall deliver any
- 19 repayment under this subchapter in a lump sum payable:
- 20 (1) to both the lender or other holder of the loan and
- 21 the nurse; or
- 22 (2) directly to the lender or other holder of the loan
- 23 on the nurse's behalf.
- 24 (b) A repayment under this subchapter may be applied to any
- 25 amount due in connection with the loan.
- Sec. 61.736. AMOUNT OF REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE. (a) A nurse
- 27 may receive loan repayment assistance under this subchapter in an

- 1 amount determined by the board, not to exceed \$5,000 for each year
- 2 the nurse establishes eligibility for the assistance.
- 3 (b) The total amount of loan repayment assistance provided
- 4 under this subchapter may not exceed the sum of:
- 5 (1) the total amount of gifts and grants accepted by
- 6 the board for the repayment assistance;
- 7 (2) legislative appropriations for the repayment
- 8 <u>assistance</u>; and
- 9 (3) other funds available to the board for the
- 10 repayment assistance.
- 11 (c) The board may adjust in an equitable manner the
- 12 <u>distribution amounts that nurses would otherwise recei</u>ve under
- 13 Subsection (a) for a year as necessary to comply with Subsection
- 14 (b).
- 15 (d) The total amount of loan repayment assistance awarded
- 16 under this section may not exceed \$6 million in a state fiscal
- 17 biennium.
- Sec. 61.737. RULES; ADMINISTRATION. (a) The board shall
- 19 adopt rules necessary to administer this subchapter.
- 20 (b) The board shall distribute to each institution of higher
- 21 education or private or independent institution of higher education
- 22 and to any appropriate state agency and professional association
- 23 copies of the rules adopted under this section and other pertinent
- 24 information relating to this subchapter.
- (c) The board shall administer the program under this
- 26 subchapter in a manner that maximizes any matching funds available
- 27 through other sources.

- 1 (d) A reasonable amount, not to exceed three percent, of any
- 2 money appropriated for purposes of this subchapter may be used to
- 3 pay the costs of administering this subchapter.
- 4 Sec. 61.738. SOLICITATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS. The
- 5 board may solicit and accept gifts and grants from any public or
- 6 private source for the purposes of this subchapter.
- 7 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board is
- 8 required to provide assistance in the repayment of eligible student
- 9 loans for eligible nurses as provided by this Act only if the
- 10 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
- 11 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 12 purpose, the board may, but is not required to, provide assistance
- 13 in the repayment of eligible student loans for eligible nurses as
- 14 provided by this Act using other appropriations available for that
- 15 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
