A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the prosecution of the offense of operation of an
3	unmanned aircraft over certain facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 423.0045(a)(1-a), Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(1-a) "Critical infrastructure facility" means:
8	(A) one of the following, if completely enclosed
9	by a fence or other physical barrier that is obviously designed to
10	exclude intruders, or if clearly marked with a sign or signs that
11	are posted on the property, are reasonably likely to come to the
12	attention of intruders, and indicate that entry is forbidden:
13	(i) a petroleum or alumina refinery;
14	(ii) an electrical power generating
15	facility, substation, switching station, or electrical control
16	center;
17	(iii) a chemical, polymer, or rubber
18	manufacturing facility;
19	(iv) a water intake structure, water
20	treatment facility, wastewater treatment plant, or pump station;
21	(v) a natural gas compressor station;
22	(vi) a liquid natural gas terminal or
23	storage facility;
24	(vii) a telecommunications central

- 1 switching office or any structure used as part of a system to
- 2 provide wired or wireless telecommunications services;
- 3 (viii) a port, <u>a public or private airport</u>
- 4 depicted in any current aeronautical chart published by the Federal
- 5 Aviation Administration, a railroad switching yard, a trucking
- 6 terminal, or any other freight transportation facility;
- 7 (ix) a gas processing plant, including a
- 8 plant used in the processing, treatment, or fractionation of
- 9 natural gas;
- 10 (x) a transmission facility used by a
- 11 federally licensed radio or television station;
- 12 (xi) a steelmaking facility that uses an
- 13 electric arc furnace to make steel;
- 14 (xii) a dam that is classified as a high
- 15 hazard by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; [or]
- 16 (xiii) a concentrated animal feeding
- 17 operation, as defined by Section 26.048, Water Code; or
- 18 (xiv) a military installation owned or
- 19 operated by or for the federal government, the state, or another
- 20 governmental entity; or
- 21 (B) if enclosed by a fence or other physical
- 22 barrier obviously designed to exclude intruders:
- (i) any portion of an aboveground oil, gas,
- 24 or chemical pipeline;
- 25 (ii) an oil or gas drilling site;
- 26 (iii) a group of tanks used to store crude
- 27 oil, such as a tank battery;

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- 1 (iv) an oil, gas, or chemical production
- 2 facility;
- 3
 (v) an oil or gas wellhead; or
- 4 (vi) any oil and gas facility that has an
- 5 active flare.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 9 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 10 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 11 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 12 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 13 before that date.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
