BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2206.154, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to 7 read as follows:

Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (b) and 8 (a) (b-1), not later than February 1 of each year, an entity described 9 10 by Section 2206.151 shall submit to the comptroller a report containing records and other information specified by this 11 12 subchapter for the purpose of providing the comptroller with 13 information to maintain the eminent domain database under Section 2206.153. The entity shall submit the report in a form and in the 14 manner prescribed by the comptroller. 15

(b-1) A political subdivision described by Subsection (b-2) 16 17 is required to file an annual report under Subsection (a) only if the political subdivision's eminent domain authority information 18 has changed from the information reported in the most recent report 19 filed by the political subdivision under this section. If for the 20 current annual reporting period the political subdivision's 21 22 eminent domain authority information is the same as the information reflected for the political subdivision in the eminent domain 23 24 database for the previous annual reporting period, the political

3	electronically updating the political subdivision's previously

6	(b-2) Subsection (b-1) applies to the following political

8	(1) a public school district located in a county with a
9	population of less than 25,000;
10	(2) a municipality or county with a population of less

12	(3) a district created under Section 52, Article III,
13	or Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, with a population
14	of less than 25,000.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
