## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to certain county road reports.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 251.018, Transportation Code, is
5	repealed.
6	SECTION 2. Section 256.104(a), Transportation Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(a) In applying for a grant under this subchapter, the
9	county shall[+
10	[ <del>(1) provide the road condition report described by</del>
11	Section 251.018 made by the county for the previous year; and
12	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ submit to the department a plan that:
13	(1) [ <del>(A)</del> ] provides a list of transportation
14	infrastructure projects to be funded by the grant;
15	(2) [ <del>(B)</del> ] describes the scope of the transportation
16	infrastructure project or projects to be funded by the grant using
17	best practices for prioritizing the projects;
18	<u>(3)</u> [ <del>(C)</del> ] provides for matching funds as required by
19	Section 256.105; and
20	(4) [ <del>(D)</del> ] meets any other requirements imposed by the
21	department.
22	SECTION 3. Section 256.106(a), Transportation Code, is
23	amended to read as follows:
24	(a) A county that makes a second or subsequent application

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1 for a grant from the department under this subchapter must:

2 (1) [provide the department with a copy of a report 3 filed under Section 251.018;

4 [(2)] certify that all previous grants are being spent 5 in accordance with the plan submitted under Section 256.104; and

6 (2) [(3)] provide an accounting of how previous grants
7 were spent, including any amounts spent on administrative costs.

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
