- 11 SECTION 3. Section 256.104(a), Transportation Code, is

- 3 SECTION 4. Section 256.106(a), Transportation Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) A county that makes a second or subsequent application
- 6 for a grant from the department under this subchapter must:
- 7 (1) [provide the department with a copy of a report
- 8 filed under Section 251.018;
- 9  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  certify that all previous grants are being spent
- 10 in accordance with the plan submitted under Section 256.104; and
- 11 (2) [<del>(3)</del>] provide an accounting of how previous grants
- 12 were spent, including any amounts spent on administrative costs.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
