1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the authority of a county to issue bonds to restore or
 1-20 maintain a county courthouse.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 1301.001(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (a) The commissioners court of a county may issue bonds
 1-25 authorized under Subtitle A and Chapter 1251 to:

1-26 (1) build a county courthouse or jail;

1-27 (2) purchase suitable sites in the county and to
 1-28 construct buildings on the sites for homes or schools for dependent
 1-29 or delinquent children;

1-30 (3) establish county facilities for needy or indigent
 1-31 persons in the county;

1-32 (4) purchase and construct bridges for public purposes
 1-33 in the county or to cross a stream serving as the county's boundary
 1-34 line; ~~or~~

1-35 (5) improve and maintain the public roads in the
 1-36 county; or

1-37 (6) restore or maintain a county courthouse.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
