A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the use of social determinants of health in the Medicaid
- 3 managed care program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 533.001, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subdivision (6-a) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(6-a) "Social determinants of health" means the</u>
- 8 environmental conditions in which a person is born, lives, learns,
- 9 works, plays, worships, and ages that affect a range of health,
- 10 functional, and quality of life outcomes and risks.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 533.003(a), Government Code, is amended
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 (a) In awarding contracts to managed care organizations,
- 14 the commission shall:
- 15 (1) give preference to organizations that have
- 16 significant participation in the organization's provider network
- 17 from each health care provider in the region who has traditionally
- 18 provided care to Medicaid and charity care patients;
- 19 (2) give extra consideration to organizations that
- 20 agree to assure continuity of care for at least three months beyond
- 21 the period of Medicaid eligibility for recipients;
- 22 (3) consider the need to use different managed care
- 23 plans to meet the needs of different populations;
- 24 (4) consider the ability of organizations to process

- 1 Medicaid claims electronically; and
- 2 (5) give extra consideration to organizations that use
- 3 enriched data sets incorporating social determinants of health to
- 4 manage socially complex populations in a manner that achieves:
- 5 (A) cost savings through implementation of
- 6 appropriate interventions for those populations; and
- 7 (B) favorable health outcomes for those
- 8 populations by reducing preventable emergency room visits,
- 9 <u>hospitalizations</u>, and <u>institutionalizations</u> [in the initial
- 10 implementation of managed care in the South Texas service region,
- 11 give extra consideration to an organization that either:
- 12 [(A) is locally owned, managed, and operated, if
- 13 one exists; or
- 14 [(B) is in compliance with the requirements of
- 15 Section 533.004].
- SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 533, Government Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 533.022 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 533.022. ANNUAL REPORT ON USE OF SOCIAL DETERMINANTS
- 19 OF HEALTH. Each Medicaid managed care organization that uses
- 20 enriched data sets described by Section 533.003(a)(5) shall submit
- 21 to the commission an annual report that assesses any cost savings
- 22 and favorable health outcomes achieved by using those data sets.
- SECTION 4. Section 533.003(a), Government Code, as amended
- 24 by this Act, applies to a contract entered into or renewed on or
- 25 after the effective date of this Act. A contract entered into or
- 26 renewed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the
- 27 date the contract was entered into or renewed, and that law is

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- 1 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 5. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 3 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 4 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 5 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 6 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 7 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
