## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to an audit by the Texas Education Agency of public school
- 3 professional development training requirements.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 21.4513(a) and (b), Education Code, are 6 amended to read as follows:
- o amenaea to read as rorrows.
- 7 (a) Using only available funds and resources from public or
- 8 private sources, the agency shall [periodically] conduct an audit
- 9 at least once every four years of the professional development
- 10 requirements applicable to educators in this state <u>and any other</u>
- 11 continuing education and training requirements, including state
- 12 and federal requirements and requirements imposed by school
- 13 districts.
- 14 (b) Based on audit results, the agency, with input from
- 15 stakeholders and organizations that represent educators, shall
- 16 consider the value of maintaining existing state-mandated training
- 17 requirements relating to specific topics and seek to eliminate any
- 18 <u>unnecessary topic-specific training requirements</u>, eliminate <u>any</u>
- 19 conflicting requirements, and consolidate <u>any</u> duplicative
- 20 requirements through the following methods, as appropriate:
- 21 (1) taking administrative action;
- 22 (2) encouraging school districts to make appropriate
- 23 changes to district policies; or
- 24 (3) recommending statutory changes to the

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- 1 legislature.
- 2 SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2022, the Texas
- 3 Education Agency shall complete an audit of professional
- 4 development training requirements as required by Section 21.4513,
- 5 Education Code, as amended by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. The Texas Education Agency is required to
- 7 implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature
- 8 appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If the
- 9 legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 10 purpose, the Texas Education Agency may, but is not required to,
- 11 implement a provision of this Act using other appropriations
- 12 available for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
