- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.44(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission shall deny an application for a permit or
- 8 license for any location of an applicant who submitted a prior
- 9 application that expired or was voluntarily surrendered before the
- 10 hearing on the application was held on a protest involving
- 11 allegations of prostitution, a shooting, stabbing, or other violent
- 12 act, or an offense involving drugs, [or] trafficking of persons, or
- 13 <u>drink solicitation as described by Section 104.01</u> before the third
- 14 anniversary of the date the prior application expired or was
- 15 voluntarily surrendered.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.46(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (c) The commission shall deny for a period of one year after
- 19 cancellation an application for a mixed beverage permit or private
- 20 club registration permit for a premises where a license or permit
- 21 has been canceled during the preceding 12 months as a result of:
- 22 (1) a shooting, stabbing, or other violent act $_{i}$ [$_{\tau}$] or
- 23 (2) [as a result of] an offense involving drugs,
- 24 prostitution, [ex] trafficking of persons, or drink solicitation as

- 2 SECTION 3. Section 61.42(c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, as
- 3 effective September 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (c) The commission shall deny for a period of one year an
- 5 application for a retail dealer's on-premise license or a wine and
- 6 malt beverage retailer's permit for a premises where a license or
- 7 permit has been canceled during the preceding 12 months as a result
- 8 of:
- 9 (1) a shooting, stabbing, or other violent act; $[\tau]$ or
- 10 <u>(2)</u> [as a result of] an offense involving drugs,
- 11 prostitution, [or] trafficking of persons, or drink solicitation as
- 12 described by Section 104.01.
- 13 SECTION 4. Sections 11.44(b), 11.46(c), and 61.42(c),
- 14 Alcoholic Beverage Code, as amended by this Act, apply to an
- 15 application for an alcoholic beverage permit or license filed on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act or pending on the effective
- 17 date of this Act.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
