- 2 relating to the making of an anatomical gift.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 692A.005(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) A donor or other person authorized to make an anatomical
- 7 gift under Section 692A.004 may make a gift by a donor card or other
- 8 record signed by the donor or other person making the gift or by
- 9 authorizing that a statement or symbol indicating the donor has
- 10 made an anatomical gift be included on a donor registry. If the
- 11 donor or other person is physically unable to sign a record, the
- 12 record may be signed by another individual at the direction of the
- 13 donor or other person and must:
- 14 (1) be witnessed by at least two adults, at least one
- 15 of whom is a disinterested witness, who have signed at the request
- 16 of the donor or the other person, or be acknowledged before a notary
- 17 public; and
- 18 (2) state that the record has been signed and
- 19 witnessed or acknowledged as provided in Subdivision (1).
- SECTION 2. Section 692A.005(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 21 added to read as follows:
- (e) An anatomical gift made through an online donor registry
- 23 does not require any witnesses or the consent of any person. The
- 24 online registration is a document of gift under this chapter and

- 1 remains binding after the donor's death unless amended or revoked
- 2 by the donor.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 692A.006(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (b) A record signed pursuant to Subsection (a)(1)(C) must:
- 6 (1) be witnessed by at least two adults, at least one
- 7 of whom is a disinterested witness, who have signed at the request
- 8 of the donor or the other person, or be acknowledged before a notary
- 9 public; and
- 10 (2) state that the record has been signed and
- 11 witnessed or acknowledged as provided in Subdivision (1).
- 12 SECTION 4. Section 692A.007(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (b) A record signed pursuant to Subsection (a)(1)(B) must:
- 15 (1) be witnessed by at least two adults, at least one
- 16 of whom is a disinterested witness, who have signed at the request
- 17 of the individual, or be acknowledged before a notary public; and
- 18 (2) state that the record has been signed and
- 19 witnessed or acknowledged as provided in Subdivision (1).
- 20 SECTION 5. Chapter 692, Health and Safety Code, is
- 21 repealed.
- 22 SECTION 6. Sections 692A.005, 692A.006, and 692A.007,
- 23 Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to the
- 24 validity of a record executed on or after the effective date of this
- 25 Act. The validity of a record executed before the effective date of
- 26 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the record was
- 27 executed, and that law continues in effect for that purpose.

- 1 SECTION 7. (a) Except as otherwise provided in this
- 2 section, the changes in law made by this Act apply to:
- 3 (1) a record described by Section 692A.005, 692A.006,
- 4 or 692A.007, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, created
- 5 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act; and
- 6 (2) a judicial proceeding concerning a record
- 7 described by Subdivision (1) of this subsection that:
- 8 (A) commences on or after the effective date of
- 9 this Act; or
- 10 (B) is pending on the effective date of this Act.
- 11 (b) If the court finds that application of a provision of
- 12 this Act would substantially interfere with the effective conduct
- 13 of a judicial proceeding concerning a record described by
- 14 Subsection (a)(1) of this section that is pending on the effective
- 15 date of this Act or prejudice the rights of a party to the
- 16 proceeding, the provision of this Act does not apply, and the law in
- 17 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act applies in
- 18 those circumstances.
- 19 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
