Section 33.015(a), Human Resources Code, is 7 amended to read as follows: 8 (a) In administering the supplemental nutrition assistance program, the commission shall, except as provided by Subsection (c) 9 and Section 33.019, allow a person to comply with initial 10 eligibility requirements, including any initial interview, and 11 12 with subsequent periodic eligibility recertification requirements 13 by telephone instead of through a personal appearance at commission 14 offices if: 15 (1) the person and each member of the person's household: 16 (A) have no earned income; and 17 are elderly or persons with disabilities; or 18 (B) 19 the person is subject to a hardship, as determined (2) by commission rule. 20 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, 21 is amended by adding Section 33.019 to read as follows: 22 23 Sec. 33.019. SIMPLIFIED CERTIFICATION AND RECERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN SNAP APPLICANTS AND RECIPIENTS. 24 (a) The

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1	commission shall develop and implement simplified certification
2	and recertification requirements for supplemental nutrition
3	assistance program benefits for an individual who:
4	(1) is 60 years of age or older or is a person with a
5	disability, as determined by commission rule;
6	(2) has no earned income; and
7	(3) resides in a household in which every individual
8	residing in the household is 60 years of age or older or is a person
9	with a disability, as determined by commission rule.
10	(b) The simplified requirements must:
11	(1) allow an individual described by this section to
12	waive recertification interview requirements;
13	(2) simplify and reduce the number of verification
14	requirements for certifying and recertifying eligibility to
15	receive benefits, which must include the use of a shortened
16	application form; and
17	(3) allow the individual to remain eligible for
18	benefits for 36 months after certification and after each
19	recertification.
20	(c) An individual described by this section is required to:
21	(1) submit to the commission a change reporting form
22	every 12 months during the 36-month eligibility period; and
23	(2) report to the commission, in accordance with
24	federal law, when the individual receives an increase in income.
25	(d) The commission shall, in a manner that complies with
26	federal law, use data matching to inform eligible individuals
27	described by this section who are receiving Medicaid benefits of

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1 <u>their eligibility for supplemental nutrition assistance program</u> 2 <u>benefits.</u>

3 SECTION 3. Section 33.019, Human Resources Code, as added 4 by this Act, applies only to an application or recertification of 5 eligibility of a person for supplemental nutrition assistance 6 program benefits submitted on or after January 1, 2022.

7 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act 8 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 9 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 10 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 11 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 12 waiver or authorization is granted.

13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
