- 7 (a) A county commissioner must successfully complete at
- 8 least 16 [classroom] hours of continuing education in the
- 9 performance of the duties of county commissioners at least once in
- 10 each 12-month period.
- 11 (b) Continuing education instruction required by this
- 12 section must be certified by an accredited public institution of
- 13 higher education. The instruction may be completed online with the
- 14 approval of the commissioners court, except a county commissioner
- 15 must complete the instruction in person in the first 12-month
- 16 period of the commissioner's first term.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
