- 9 (1) Section 481.121, Health and Safety Code, if the
- 10 offense is punishable under Subsection (b)(1) or (2) of that

- 15 (2) Section 28.03, Penal Code, if the offense is

- 17 (3) Section 28.08, Penal Code, if the offense is

- 19 (3-a) Section 30.05, Penal Code, if the offense is

- 21 (4) Section 31.03, Penal Code, if the offense is

- 1 (6) Section 38.114, Penal Code, if the offense is 2 punishable as a Class B misdemeanor; or
- 3 (7) Section 521.457, Transportation Code.
- 4 SECTION 2. Article 14.06(d), Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 5 amended by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or
- 6 after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before
- 7 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 8 the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued
- 9 in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an
- 10 offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 11 element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
