3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 39.905, Utilities Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
6	(a-1) In addition to meeting the demand goals provided by
7	Subsection (a), each electric utility shall also meet an annual
8	energy savings goal of:
9	(1) one-fourth of one percent annual energy savings in
10	the 2022 calendar year;
11	(2) one-half of one percent annual energy savings in
12	the 2023 calendar year;
13	(3) three-fourths of one percent annual energy savings
14	in the 2024 calendar year; and
15	(4) one percent annual energy savings beginning with
16	the 2025 calendar year.
17	(a-2) The commission by rule shall provide a method to
18	establish each utility's annual savings goal under Subsection
19	(a-1). The method must be based on the existing and expected usage
20	of electricity delivered in a utility's service area that is
21	required to pay the annual energy efficiency cost recovery fee. In
22	adopting rules, the commission may provide for cost caps for the
23	implementation of Subsection (a-1) and provide good cause
24	exceptions for a utility that is unable to meet the goal in a

- 2 SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 3 adopt rules to implement the changes made by this Act to Section
- 4 39.905, Utilities Code, not later than December 31, 2021.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
