Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 13.009. ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION. (a) The 7 secretary of state shall implement a program to allow a person who has an unexpired driver's license or personal identification card 8 9 issued in this state to complete a voter registration application over the Internet from the official website of this state. The 10 websites of the secretary of state and the Department of Public 11 Safety must also provide a link to the location of the application 12 on the official website of this state. 13 14 (b) An applicant for electronic voter registration must: (1) attest to the truth of the information provided on 15 16 the application by affirmatively accepting the information as true; (2) affirmatively consent to the use of the signature 17 on the applicant's driver's license or personal identification card 18 19 for voter registration purposes; (3) provide the information required under Section 20 21 13.002(c); and 22 (4) provide the audit number and date of issuance of 23 the applicant's Texas driver's license or personal identification card issued by the Department of Public Safety. 24

1	(c) For each application the program shall:
2	(1) require that a digital copy of the applicant's
3	signature be obtained from the Department of Public Safety; and
4	(2) compare the information provided by the applicant
5	against Department of Public Safety records.
6	(d) If the information submitted by an applicant does not
7	match Department of Public Safety records, the program shall:
8	(1) notify the applicant that the application cannot
9	be processed electronically; and
10	(2) advise the applicant to print an application and
11	submit it to the voter registrar of the county in which the
12	applicant resides by mail or personal delivery.
13	(e) If the information submitted by an applicant matches
14	Department of Public Safety records, the program shall forward the
15	application to the registrar of the county in which the applicant
16	states that the applicant resides.
17	(f) On receipt of an application under Subsection (e), the
18	registrar shall review the application in accordance with Section
19	<u>13.071.</u>
20	(g) An application electronically submitted under this
21	section is considered for all purposes as an application submitted
22	by mail under this title.
23	(h) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
24	implement this section, including rules to provide for additional
25	security measures necessary to ensure the accuracy and integrity of
26	applications submitted electronically.
27	(i) The rules adopted under Subsection (h) must require

1	that:
2	(1) the Internet website through which a person may
3	complete a voter registration application include a description of
4	the offense described by Section 13.007 in a conspicuous location
5	on the website near the place where the person begins or submits the
6	application; and
7	(2) the state electronic Internet portal project be
8	used to authenticate the identity of a person who submits an
9	application electronically under this section.

10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
