- 11 <u>employee's compensation, promotion, demotion, transfer, work</u>
- 12 <u>assignment</u>, or performance evaluation.
- 13 (b) Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, an educator 14 employed by a school district for the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school
- 15 year who resigned or retired from the educator's position after the
- 16 2019-2020 school year or during the 2020-2021 school year solely
- 17 because of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic is entitled
- 18 <u>to:</u>
- 19 (1) reinstatement to the educator's former position or
- 20 <u>an equivalent position; and</u>
- 21 (2) reinstatement of any fringe benefits and seniority
- 22 rights that the educator was entitled to before the educator's
- 23 resignation or retirement.
- 24 (c) If an educator returns to employment as provided by

- 1 Subsection (b), a school district may not take any adverse
- 2 employment action against the educator based on the educator's
- 3 decision to resign or retire after the 2019-2020 school year or
- 4 during the 2020-2021 school year.
- 5 (d) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 6 implement this section.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 8 school year.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
