14	TRIBE. The Lipan Apache Tribe of Texas is designated and recognized
15	by this state as a Native American Indian Tribe exercising

- substantial governmental powers and duties. The tribe is
 recognized as eligible for all programs, services, authorizations,
 including marketing and sales authorizations, and other benefits
- 19 provided to state-recognized Native American Indian Tribes by the
- 20 United States, this state, or any other state because of the tribe
- 21 members' status as Native American Indians.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
