A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the practice of chiropractic. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 201.002(a), Occupations Code, is amended 4 5 by adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as follows: 6 (3-a) "Neuromusculoskeletal system" means the musculoskeletal and nervous systems in relation to disorders that 7 manifest in both systems, including disorders of a biomechanical or 8 9 functional nature. SECTION 2. Section 201.002(b), Occupations Code, is amended 10 11 to read as follows: 12 (b) A person practices chiropractic under this chapter if 13 the person: 14 (1) uses objective or subjective means to diagnose, analyze, examine, or evaluate the biomechanical condition of the 15 spine and neuromusculoskeletal [musculoskeletal] system of the 16 human body; 17 18 (2) performs nonsurgical, nonincisive procedures, including adjustment and manipulation, to improve the subluxation 19 biomechanics of 20 complex or the the neuromusculoskeletal 21 [musculoskeletal] system; 22 (3) represents to the public that the person is a 23 chiropractor; or (4) uses the term "chiropractor," "chiropractic," 24

"doctor of chiropractic," "D.C.," or any derivative of those terms
or initials in connection with the person's name.

3 SECTION 3. Section 201.003, Occupations Code, is amended by 4 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

5 (b-1) This chapter does not permit the unauthorized 6 practice of medicine.

7 amendments made SECTION 4. The by this Act are а 8 clarification of existing law in light of ongoing litigation over whether any part of the nervous system is within the scope of 9 chiropractic and do not imply that existing law may be construed as 10 inconsistent with the law as amended by this Act. 11

12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
