 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the criminal history record information requirement for
 1-20 applicants for renewal of a license issued by the Texas State Board
 1-21 of Public Accountancy.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. The Texas State Board of Public Accountancy
 1-24 shall require each applicant for renewal of a license under
 1-25 Subchapter I, Chapter 901, Occupations Code, to first comply with
 1-26 the requirement of Section 901.169(a), Occupations Code, not later
 1-27 than September 1, 2022. Notwithstanding Sections 901.169(a)(2)(E)
 1-28 and 901.403(c), Occupations Code, an applicant for renewal of a
 1-29 license is not required to comply with Section 901.169(a),
 1-30 Occupations Code, until first required to by the board as provided
 1-31 by this Act.

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 22(d), Chapter 181 (H.B. 1520), Acts of
 1-33 the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, is repealed.

1-34 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
