Section 169.003, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 169.003. PRESCRIPTION OF LOW-THC CANNABIS. A physician 8 described by Section 169.002 may prescribe low-THC cannabis to a 9 patient if: 10 (1) the patient is a permanent resident of the state; 11 12 (2) the physician complies with the registration requirements of Section 169.004; and 13 14 (3) the physician certifies to the department that: 15 (A) the patient is diagnosed with: (i) epilepsy; 16 17 (ii) a seizure disorder; 18 (iii) multiple sclerosis; (iv) spasticity; 19 (v) amyotrophic lateral sclerosis; 20 21 (vi) autism; 22 (vii) terminal cancer; [or] 23 (viii) an incurable neurodegenerative 24 disease; or

1	(ix) post-traumatic stress disorder; and
2	(B) the physician determines the risk of the
3	medical use of low-THC cannabis by the patient is reasonable in
4	light of the potential benefit for the patient.
5	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
